Ninety feet above the surface of the James River, where the Confederate States Naval Academy ship *Patrick Henry* was anchored, Drewry's Bluff was home to the James River Squadron and three companies of Confederate marines. Located south of Richmond, on a bend in the James River, the Confederate fort known as the *Gibraltar of the Confederacy* successfully kept the United States Navy at bay for nearly three years of war.
