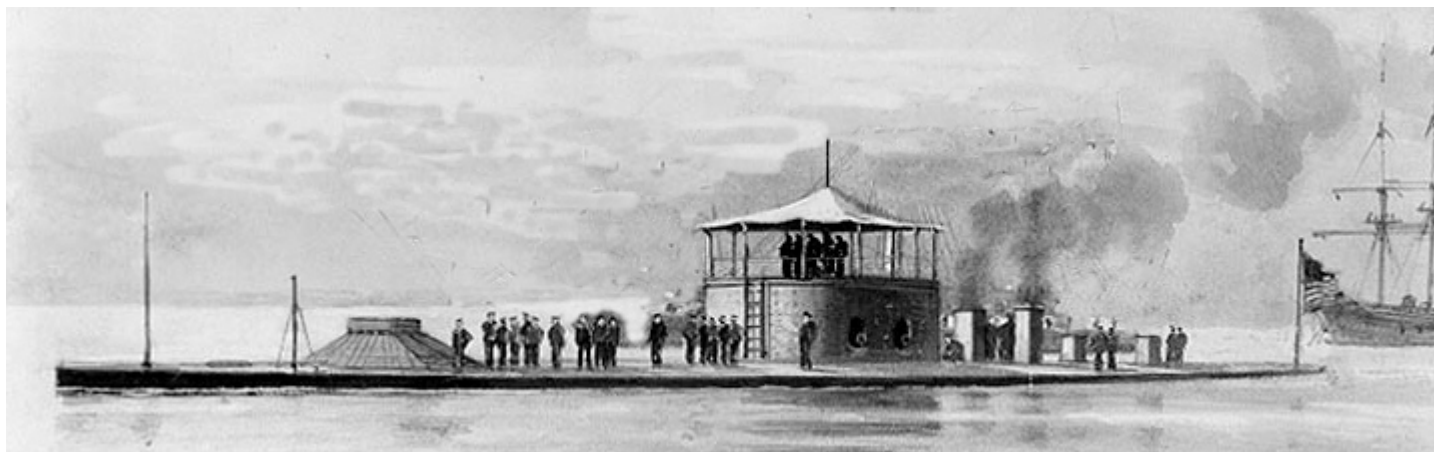

Revisiting the Monitor

with Jeff Johnston

On March 9th 1862, the Ironclads *CSS Virginia* and *USS Monitor* clashed in the waters off Newport News, Virginia. Battling to a draw, the *Virginia* would never see combat again, while the *Monitor* and many of her crew would soon be lost, foundering in rough seas off Cape Hatteras, her final resting place unknown for over a century.

But that's just the beginning of the *Monitor's* story. Discovered in 1973, placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1974, and designated a marine sanctuary in 1975 the *Monitor* is finally yielding some of her many secrets.



Our friend, maritime historian Jeff Johnston of the *USS Monitor* National Marine Sanctuary, will join us on November 15th to bring us up to date on the continuing saga of the legendary *USS Monitor*.
